

Pastor Network Starter

A practical starting point for pastors who want to pray together, cover local schools, and encourage one another throughout the year.

Connect within your network Begin with existing denominational, ministerial, and relational connections.	Invite pastors you know Invite like-minded leaders across churches and backgrounds who share a heart for students.	Build a community rhythm Gather pastors in your city or county to pray, share school connections, and encourage one another.
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You do not have to pray for your community alone.

Invite pastors in your ministry network, denomination, city, or region to share responsibility for the schools around you.

The goal is not another committee. It is a simple rhythm of prayer, encouragement, and practical coordination.

START HERE

Invite the first conversation

A personal invitation works better than a broad announcement.

Invitation language

I would love to gather a few pastors to pray for the schools in our community, compare the campus relationships we already have, and consider how we can encourage one another this year.

The first meeting

Keep it to one hour: pray, map relationships, identify uncovered schools, and agree on one shared next step.

USE THIS CHECKLIST

- Invite five to ten pastors personally.
- Choose a neutral or rotating location.
- Do not launch a program before listening.

MONTHLY RHYTHM

Keep encouragement simple

A repeatable rhythm creates more trust than a large one-time event.

Pray

Name students, educators, campuses, and specific requests shared by school leaders.

Connect

Share which churches already know which campuses and where a relationship can be strengthened.

Encourage

Celebrate consistent service without exaggerating impact or exposing private student stories.

USE THIS CHECKLIST

- Send a short monthly prayer update.
- Share local prayer walk dates.
- Keep church and school connection notes current.

SHARED MISSION

Together, we can pray for every school, encourage one another, and seek open doors for the Gospel across our communities.
